Beef Management Calendar

The following is a check list for management practices for the month of June.

- Check mineral feeders, use at least 8% phosphorus in mineral and not over 2½ to 1 calcium to phosphorus ratio.
- Check pastures and hay fields for spittlebugs, mole cricket and army worms. Treat if necessary; this is the best month for mole cricket control.
- Check dust bags.
- Watch for evidence of pinkeye and treat.
- Vaccinate heifers for brucellosis if not already done.
- Pregnancy check cows.
- Put bulls out June 1 for calves starting March 11.
- Implant calves at 90 to 120 days with growth stimulant.
